## Pest Information

- [Pseudomonas \(Bacterial Blight\)](#) **blueberries**: Water-soaked lesions usually appear at this time of year on canes in some fields that then develop into a **reddish brown to black cankers**. Cankers may extend from a fraction of an inch to the entire length of 1-year-old wood. Buds in cankers die. If girdled, the cane portion above the canker dies. **Recommended management**: The lesions now being seen are the effects of past infections. To prevent future lesions from forming, copper sprays are recommended starting when the temperatures get warmer, usually around **mid-February** in the Willamette Valley and SW Washington. **Good coverage** is essential with copper.
- [Voles](#): Vole activity is apparent in some blueberry and caneberry fields. Management of voles is most effective in the spring before they start multiplying like...voles.
